### Recycling Guidelines

|  |   |

| <b>Category:</b>                         | <b>July 6th &amp; September 7th collections canceled</b>  |
| <b>Aluminum Cans:</b>                    | Empty and rinse cans. No food residue. Keep separate from tin. Crushing is optional but saves space.  |
| <b>Clear Glass:</b>                      | Food and beverage bottles & jars only. Keep clear separate from colored. Remove lids and rings. Rinse well. No food residue. Labels can remain.   |
| <b>Colored Glass:</b>                    | Food and beverage bottles & jars only. Keep colored glass separate from clear. Remove lids and rings. Rinse well. No food residue. Labels can remain.   |
| <b>Corrugated Cardboard:</b>             | Flatten boxes & keep dry. Remove all plastic wrap and packing material such as Styrofoam, foam peanuts, air pillows, etc. No paperboard such as cereal/tissue boxes. No waxy or greasy cardboard.   |
| <b>Mixed Paper:</b>                      | Includes junk mail, magazines, catalogs, newspaper, paperback books, colored paper, shredded paper. Keep dry. Do not bundle, bag, or tie.   |
| <b>Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Jars, Tubs</b> | Recycle only bottles, jugs, jars, & tubs. Includes water & soda bottles, laundry and milk jugs, shampoo bottles, yogurt container, butter tubs. Empty and rinse. No food residue. Lids can remain. Crush to save space.<br><b>No black plastic, No flower pots, No hard/bulky plastic, No plastic bags, No oil containers, No Styrofoam</b> |
| <b>Steel/"Tin" Cans:</b>                 | Rinse and secure lids inside. No food residue. Keep separate from aluminum. Labels can remain.  |

ALL MATERIALS MUST BE SORTED BY CATEGORY AND LOOSE IN THE CONTAINER
