Recycling Guidelines

July 4, 2022 and January 2, 2023 COLLECTION CANCELED

Aluminum Cans: Please empty & rinse cans (no food residue). Keep separate from tin. Crushing is optional but saves space.

Corrugated Cardboard: Flatten boxes & keep dry. Look for the ridges. No cereal/macaroni boxes, etc.

Glass Bottles & Jars: Food and beverage containers only. Separate clear from colored glass (brown & green).

Remove all lids & rings. Rinse well (no food residue). Labels can remain

Mixed Paper: Includes junk mail, office paper, newspaper/inserts, magazines, envelopes, colored paper, shredded paper, etc.

Keep dry. Do not bundle or tie.

Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Jars, & Tubs: Includes soda & water bottles, milk & laundry jugs, shampoo bottles, yogurt containers,

butter tubs, etc...Empty & rinse (no food residue). Lids can remain. Crushing is optional but saves space.

NO HARD OR BULKY PLASTICS, NO BLACK PLASTIC, NO PLASTIC BAGS, NO STYROFOAM, NO OIL CONTAINERS, NO FLOWER POTS

Steel/"Tin" Cans: Rinse & secure the lid inside. Keep separate from aluminum. No food residue. Labels can remain.

Commodities must be sorted by type within your curbside bin by using bags, dividers, or separate bins for each material. Bagging plastics is acceptable for curbside collection.

Materials not properly prepared are still trash!
